DESTINATION: Hanoi, Sapa, Halong Bay, Hue, Ho Chi Minh

DURATION: 12 Days

Let's take a hale and hearty adventure to eccentric destinations in Vietnam. Upon your arrival to an astonishing Hanoi, relax before the journey to the striking beauty of Sapa by a private comfortable car. Walk through the rice terraces, visit ethnic villages, and hike in remote areas out of crowds. Stunning landscape, ideal weather, clouds, mountains, rice field terrace - all this will harmonize and freshen up your soul. Enjoy the relaxing cruise in Ha Long Bay to recover after a few days of trekking and admire the most beautiful sceneries you have ever seen.

Then fly to a mild Hue. An adventure lover never grabs an ordinary tour, but cycles in an ancient village, Thuy Bieu, gracefully surrounded by many great views and sightseeings. Enjoy cooking local food, see traditional houses, and visit local workshops. Lastly, Ho Chi Minh will be uncovered in a unique way - by the Jeep tour. Independence Palace, Museum of American War Crimes, Notre Dame Cathedral, and the Old Post Office are the highlights that no one can miss out on. After 12-day of discovery, do not hesitate to tell the world that you have tasted one of the truly adventurous tours ever.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO VIETNAM - HANOI ARRIVAL

Your Vietnam adventure begins with your arrival in Hanoi. Your private driver will meet you at the airport, holding a signboard with your name. He will escort you to your accommodation right in the heart of the city, with the fascinating Old Quarter at your fingertips. You can easily explore the city at your own pace or relax at the hotel after the flight.

Overnight in Hanoi

DAY 2: HANOI – TRANSFER TO SAPA BY LIMOUSINE BUS – VISITING TA PHIN VILLAGE

Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready for your Sapa exploration. You will be transferred to Sapa by limousine bus. Upon arrival in Sapa have lunch and check-in at the hotel. Later you will visit Ta Phin village. Located in a large valley, surrounded by high mountains, covered by pine trees and forest, Ta Phin commune is home to the Red Dzao and Black Hmong ethnicities. Despite living close to each other for decades, these two ethnic people are very different. The Hmongs are cheerful and open-minded, while the Red Dzaos are economical and reserved.

Take a short drive to the center of the valley, where you will enjoy an easy walk following the village path around the valley, paying a visit to Hmong hamlets scattering from the bottom of the valley to higher mountain slopes. From high elevation you will enjoy the great view of the valley stretching under your feet. Continue your walk to the Red Dzao village, where you will meet a group of women making handicrafts, including embroidered clothes and handbags. Later you will be transferred back to Sapa.

Approx: 1.5 hours walking.

Overnight in Sapa

DAY 3: TREKKING THROUGH THE RICE TERRACES – LAO CHAI – TA VAN –GIANG TA CHAI

The day is devoted to a beautiful hike through the breathtaking scenery of Sa Pa valley. Start the walk with a picturesque road where you can admire the rice terraces hidden behind the mist of the morning, a truly awe-inspiring sight.

Follow a small track crossing the Muong Hoa River and pass well-tended rice terraces on your way to the Black Hmong village of Lao Chai. Continue walking through the colorful rice terraces, and you will reach the village of Ta Van Giay. As you continue your trek along the Muong Hoa River, you will cross a small suspension bridge, roughly 2km from the settlement. Here you can discover a fascinating collection of rock carvings. These engravings depict some beautiful images of man, stilt houses, and some beautiful decorative patterns.

Have lunch in a local house. After lunch, continue your walk through the bamboo forest to Giang Ta Chai, a Red Dao ethnic minority village. After taking a rest nearby a waterfall to refresh, you start climbing uphill to a road where the car is ready for your journey back to Sapa.

Approx: 1-hour driving and 4 hours walking

Overnight in Sapa

DAY 4: TREKKING OUT OF THE CROWD - BAN KHOANG - TA GIANG PHINH (B/L)

Today you will leave the busy life behind to enjoy a nice walk in a quiet non-touristic area. Have breakfast at the hotel and meet your guide and driver. Head northwards of Sapa with several stops for viewing the magnificent landscapes of Fansipan, Sin Chai valley, and flower and vegetable farms. Then follow a narrow road for half an hour drive getting through the wild region with thick rain forest covering walled-up mountains. On the way, you will pass several waterfalls before

arriving at Ban Khoang, a village of the Red Zao ethnic peoples who live their unique way of life and well maintain their traditional values. The village looks prosperous thanks to the combination of wet rice cultivation on the terraced fields with cardamom farming under the shade of trees in a thick forest. Spend over an hour walking to explore this remote village for a better understanding of local life. Leaving Ban Khoang and process along the road for about 10km to Ta Giang Phinh valley the home for the Black Hmongs who live in small villages scattering along a peaceful stream.

Enjoy a picnic lunch on the bank of a stream before walking along the village path, which connects the villages to each other to witness the daily activities of locals such as plowing and harrowing the fields, growing, harvesting rice and vegetables, or doing some house work. In leisure months men often gather to build new houses or repair parts of old ones while women stay home making their traditional costumes. The walk ends in mid-afternoon when you will head back to Sapa by car.

Approx: 2 hours driving and 4 hours walking

Overnight in Sapa

DAY 5: SAPA – TRANSFER TO HANOI (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and have some leisure time, until you will be transferred tback to Hanoi by limousine bus. Rest of the day is at your leisure.

Overnight in Hanoi

DAY 6: HANOI - HALONG BAY - OVERNIGHT ON CRUISE (B/L/D)

In the morning, check out of the hotel, and get picked up by the Cruise team. Take the most scenic route to reach Halong Bay, taking you across the Red River Delta with emerald green rice paddies stretching for as far as the eyes can see.

On arrival at Halong, you will board the cruise and enjoy the fantastic views of limestone rocks and the karst grottoes. Have an utterly delicious seafood lunch and enjoy the time at the sundeck exploring the Bay.

The cruise will stop in a secret place where you will spend time kayaking or swimming, so you can explore the karst grottoes closer. Towards the evening, you will return to the boat for an early dinner, followed by some time at leisure. You can optionally attend the activities taking part on the boat or just relax.

Overnight on cruise

DAY 7: HALONG BAY - HANOI (B/L)

Rise early today to view the dawn at the Wonder of the Nature World with breakfast served in the dining room. A Tai Chi class on the sun deck will awake your mind and muscles.

Then head off to visit the limestone cave full of stalagmites and stalactites. Then return to the boat to check out and enjoy the brunch while the cruise is sailing back to the harbor. Later you will be transferred to your accommodation in Hanoi.

Overnight in Hanoi

DAY 8: TRAVEL FROM HANOI TO HUE CITY - FLIGHT INCLUDED (B)

Relish the remaining moment in Hanoi before your private driver escorts you to the airport to take the flight to Hue. When you arrive at Hue airport, your driver will pick you up and transfer you to your accommodation. The rest of the time is free at leisure.

Overnight in Hue

DAY 9: HUE COUNTRYSIDE TOUR TO THUY BIEU VILLAGE (B/L)

Start your day by exploring the idyllic destinations in Thien Mu pagoda – a historic temple, the symbol of Vietnam in the Nguyen Dynasty before arriving in Thuy Bieu Village. Upon arrival in the village, enjoy a welcome drink at the local house. Then take a cycling trip around the village to see the daily life of the local people. Stop to visit an incense-making, joss-paper making, and paper-painting family workshops to see countryside paintings of young local artists.

After biking around the village, you will be back to the local house to have a foot massage before cooking your lunch under the instruction of our chef. The chef will teach you to cook some famous local foods such as fig salad mixed with shrimp and pork, Banh Ram It (a patty of super-crunchy deep-fried stick rice topped with stir-fried shrimp and pork), and Banh Khoái (a pan-fried crepe that is typically stuffed with shrimp and pork). Enjoy the meals you cooked for lunch and take some rest before driving back to your hotel.

Overnight in Hue

DAY 10: TRAVEL FROM HUE TO HO CHI MINH - FLIGHT INCLUDED (B)

Relish the remaining moment in Hue before your private driver escorts you to the airport to take the flight to Ho Chi Minh. When you arrive at Tan Son Nhat International Airport, your driver will pick you up and transfer you to your accommodation. The rest of the time is free at leisure.

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh

DAY 11: EXPLORE THE VIBRANT CITY BY JEEP CAR (B)

Today you will explore the most remarkable places of Ho Chi Minh city in military-style by Jeep.

Have breakfast at your hotel before your guide and driver pick you up to begin your Jeep adventure. Drive through Saigon streets towards the Independence Palace/ the Reunification Palace. The palace is a symbolic destination of the end of the Vietnam War during the Fall of Saigon on April 30, 1975, when the North Vietnamese Army tank number 843 crashed through the gates of what was the residence of the President of the Republic of Vietnam.

Next, you will admire the Museum of American War Crimes/ the War Remnants Museum is the most popular museum in Ho Chi Minh City. It gathers a collection of the machinery, weapons, photos, and documentation of Vietnam's wars.

After the Museum, you will see Notre Dame Cathedral and the Old Post Office, which are the best highlights of old Saigon architecture and are located next to each other right in the heart of Ho Chi Minh City.

And then, Jeep will take you for a drive along famous roads in Saigon as Dong Khoi street, and Nguyen Hue street, and head to Ben Thanh Market, a lively market in District 1, where your guide can help you barter for goods. And then, Jeep goes to Bui Vien street and back to your hotel.

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City

DAY 12: TIME TO SAY GOODBYE – HO CHI MINH DEPARTURE (B)

Relish a healthy breakfast on the final day of your trip to Vietnam. Complete the hotel check-out formalities, after which you can visit the local markets to buy souvenirs for your loved ones. Later your private driver will transfer you to the airport to take your flight back home.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO VIETNAM – HANOI ARRIVAL

Welcome to Vietnam! Your new adventure begins with your arrival in Hanoi. Your private driver will meet you at the airport, holding a signboard with your name. He will escort you to your accommodation right in the heart of the city, with the fascinating Old Quarter at your fingertips. You can easily explore the city at your own pace or relax at the hotel after the flight.

Overnight in Hanoi

Day 2: HANOI CITY TOUR (B/L)

Explore the charming city of Hanoi, often referred to as the "Paris of the East", with its yellow colonial buildings, tree-lined boulevards, and scenic lakes. Start your exploration by visiting the historic Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, an imposing monument made of marble and granite where the preserved body of beloved revolutionary leader Ho Chi Minh is resting. Next to the mausoleum, you will see One Pillar Pagoda, Hanoi's iconic Buddhist temple built in 1049 in the shape of a lotus blossom.

Continue your tour to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first national university, built in the late 11th century and dedicated to Confucius studies. This picturesque temple is an example of well-preserved traditional Vietnamese architecture. Enjoy the tranquil atmosphere and get a touch of Vietnamese history and culture.

In the afternoon, you will learn about the traditions of Vietnam and its ethnic diversity with a visit to the Museum of Ethnology (closed on Mondays), which houses an extensive collection of traditional costumes and artifacts from Vietnam's 54 ethnic minority groups.

Drive back to central Hanoi for a walking tour through the maze of narrow streets of the fascinating Old Quarter. Its "36 streets of 36 wares" are named after the original 36 artisan guilds, which were located here in the 13th century.

Wrap up your day with the entertaining water puppet performance. It is a uniquely Northern Vietnamese form of art, that originated in the flooded rice fields of the Red River Delta, where

villagers entertained themselves by manipulating puppets over the water. Enjoy watching the colorful wooden puppets showing the episodes of local legends and history.

Suggested departure time: 08:00

Overnight in Hanoi

DAY 3: EXPLORE THE NATURE BEAUTY OF NINH BINH (B/L)

Meet your guide at the hotel and depart Hanoi for a 2hr drive to the Trang An Landscape Complex in Ninh Binh Province. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is famed for its spectacular landscape of limestone karst peaks that rise abruptly 200m (656ft) above the surrounding land and water. You will enjoy the views of the cliffs covered by dense rainforests blending with rice paddy fields and rivers.

Start your Ning Binh exploration with a visit to Vietnam's ancient capital of Hoa Lu, the country's first centralized feudal state from the end of the 10th century. Explore the remaining temples of the Dinh and Le dynasties surrounded by rice paddies.

Then continue to Tam Coc, known as "Halong Bay on Land", where you will take a 2-hours journey by rowboat through the winding river and canals. Enjoy the views of the beautiful karst formations as you enter three of the many natural caves formed under the hills. Visit the Thai Vi temple on the way back to Tam Coc for lunch. Return to Hanoi late afternoon.

Overnight in Hanoi

Suggested departure time: at 7:30 am

DAY 4: HANOI – HALONG BAY (B/L/D)

In the morning, check out of the hotel, and get picked up by the Cruise team. Take the most scenic route to reach Halong Bay, taking you across the Red River Delta with emerald green rice paddies stretching for as far as the eyes can see.

On arrival at the pier, you will board the cruise and enjoy the fantastic views of limestone rocks and the karst grottoes. Have an utterly delicious seafood lunch and enjoy the time at the sundeck exploring the Bay.

The cruise will stop in a secret place where you will spend time kayaking or swimming, so you can explore the karst grottoes closer. Towards the evening, you will return to the boat for an early dinner, followed by some time at leisure. You can optionally attend the activities taking part on the boat or just relax.

Overnight on cruise

DAY 5: HA LONG BAY – FLIGHT TO HUE (B)

Rise early today to view the sunrise at the wonder of nature with breakfast served in the dining room. A Tai Chi class on the sun deck will awake your mind and muscles.

Then head off to visit the limestone cave full of stalagmites and stalactites. After your exploration return to the boat to check out and enjoy the brunch while the cruise is sailing back to the harbor. Later you will be transferred to the Noi Bai International Airport for your flight to Hue. Upon arrival in Hue, you will be transferred to the hotel.

Overnight in Hue

DAY 6: HUE ANCIENT CITY EXPLORATION (B/L)

Today you will explore the once-imperial capital of the Nguyen Dynasty, its rich cultural heritage, and royal charm.

Start your morning with a short cyclo ride from your hotel to the Imperial Citadel, the UNESCO World Heritage site. Enter through the towering main gate and appreciate the magnificent architecture and gardens while your guide explains the events and the intrigue surrounding the former royal court. Despite being heavily bombed during the Vietnam War, there are some incredibly well-preserved sections and some others which were carefully restored. Then drive to the Thien Mu Pagoda, Hue’s best-preserved religious monument, which was built in 1601. This tower pagoda, with seven levels, is located on the top of the hill overlooking the Perfume River and is one of Vietnam’s most recognizable icons.

In the afternoon, we will head out of town to explore the elegant Khai Dinh Royal Tomb. Its architecture combines Eastern and Western design traditions and is considered the most beautiful royal tomb in the country. Then we will see the splendid Tu Duc Royal Tomb. This impressive tomb is the resting place of Emperor Tu Duc, but no one knows the exact place, where he is buried, as all the servants, who were involved in the funeral, were beheaded to keep the emperor’s last place in secret.

Overnight in Hue

Suggested departure time: 9:00 am

DAY 7: HUE – HOI AN ANCIENT CITY (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready for the transfer from Hue to Hoi An by private car. You will drive through one of the most beautiful roads in the world - Hai Van Pass. You will be blown away by the stunning views of the mountains and the sea. Upon arrival in Hue check in the hotel and have free time to explore the surrounding area.

Overnight in Hoi An

Suggested departure time: 09:00

Transfer duration: 03 hours

DAY 8: CYCLING CAM THANH & THANH DONG ORGANIC FARM (B/L)

Enjoy the delicious breakfast at the hotel and get ready for the countryside exploration. In the morning, you will drive to Vong Nhi village. Upon arrival, hop on the bikes and cycle through the village (around 6 km). Enjoy the stunning landscapes and peaceful countryside views, such as green coconut forest, and prawn and red snapper farms or immerse in the rustic beauty of rice fields.

Then arrive at Thanh Dong organic farm. This 10,000 sqm garden with fresh organic goods supports 10 local families for a living. Take a stroll around the vegetable garden and listen to the life-changing story of the farmers about how they have been approaching the organic method of cultivating herbs. Afterward, you will join the farmers in their gardening activities, like preparing and applying organic manure to the land, raking the ground, sowing herb seeds, and watering or picking vegetables.

Say goodbye to the farmers and take a ride in the unique Vietnamese basket boat along the Do River to The Field Restaurant. On the way, admire the beautiful scenery and local countryside life. Take part in a short cooking class to make Vietnamese family-style lunch. Enjoy the meals you cooked and get back to your hotel.

Overnight in Hoi An

Suggested departure time: 08:00

Tour duration: 03 hours

DAY 9: HOI AN FLIGHT TO HO CHI MINH (B)

Have a relaxing morning, and get ready for your flight to Ho Chi Minh. Your private driver will meet you at the hotel lobby and transfer you to Da Nang Airport, where you will board the plane. Upon arrival in Ho Chi Minh, you will be welcomed and transferred to the hotel for check-in and to have some rest after the flight.

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh

DAY 10: EXPLORE THE LUSH BEAUTY OF MEKONG DELTA (B/L)

Enjoy the delicious breakfast at the hotel and meet your guide at the hotel lobby. Today you will explore the maze of waterways and the lush green gardens of the Mekong Delta. Take a 1.5 hours drive to Ben Tre, situated in the Mekong River Delta. At the pier, embark on a fascinating motorboat that will take you to Cai Be floating market. See how locals sell their fruits and vegetables right from the boats. Then, take the rowing boat to go deeper into the countryside through small canals to enjoy a peaceful atmosphere.

Get back on a motor boat and cruise along one of the longest Mekong rivers observing the daily activities of the local farmers and fishermen.

Arrive at An Binh Island, where you will enjoy Vietnamese lunch at the local homestay.

In the afternoon, we will take you for a walk around the orchards to enjoy a cup of tea while listening life performance of the traditional Vietnamese music in the ancient house.

Now it's time to take a walk around the village and visit the local workshops to see how to make rice paper, coconut candies, and pop-rice. If you would like, you also can join the cycling trip through the village roads to see the local daily life at the orchard, school, church, pagoda, and traditional houses.

Then visit the brick kilns where you can see how the local people create beautiful clay pottery. Your cruise will end at Vinh Long city, from where you will head back to Saigon by private car.

Tour duration: 8.5 hours

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh

DAY 11: HO CHI MINH HALF DAY CITY TOUR (B/L)

With over eight million inhabitants and four million motorbikes, Saigon is truly a city that never sleeps. Despite its modernity, Saigon maintains strong links to the past, what you will see and feel today.

Start your tour with Saigon's most historic landmark - Notre Dame Cathedral, a red brick edifice with twin spires constructed from materials imported from France (the entrance is permitted only when no services are being performed). Then head across the square to the Central Post Office, constructed in 1891. A short drive away is the former Presidential Palace, the headquarters of the Saigon Government during the American War. Continue to the War Remnants Museum for a vivid perspective of the American War through the eyes of the Vietnamese. (Please note that some of the displays are very graphic.) Experience Saigon's famed street coffee culture while your guide provides a brief language lesson as well as insights into the daily life of a Saigonese before returning to your hotel.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO VIETNAM – HANOI ARRIVAL – DINNER AT LY CLUB RESTAURANT (D)

Welcome to Vietnam! Your new adventure begins with your arrival in Hanoi. Your private driver will meet you at the airport, holding a signboard with your name. He will escort you to your accommodation right in the heart of the city, with the fascinating Old Quarter at your fingertips. You can easily explore the city at your own pace or relax at the hotel after the flight.

In the evening, enjoy the fine dining experience at Ly Club Restaurant. Located on Le Phung Hieu Street - the heart of Hanoi, Ly Club is an outstanding restaurant occupying the 19th-century French villa with interior design inspired by antiques and ornaments of the Ly dynasty. Enjoy the incredible dishes of modern Vietnamese cuisine with live music performances. After dinner, you will be transferred back to your hotel.

Overnight in Hanoi

DAY 2: HANOI HALF DAY CITY TOUR AND TASTE THE HANOI STREET FOOD WITH FOOD BLOGGER (B/L)

Today you will explore Hanoi, with its ochre-colored colonial buildings, tree-lined boulevards, and scenic lakes. Start your tour by having coffee with your guide in the Old Quarter and chatting about the daily life of Hanoians. Then visit the historic Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum. In the Ho Chi Minh complex, you also will see One Pillar Pagoda, Hanoi's iconic Buddhist temple built in 1049 in the shape of a lotus blossom.

Continue your tour to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first national university, built in the late 11th century and dedicated to Confucius studies. This picturesque temple is an example of well-preserved traditional Vietnamese architecture. Enjoy the tranquil atmosphere and get a touch of Vietnamese history and culture. Then head back to your hotel for some relaxing time.

The Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is closed every Monday & Friday, all morning 15 June to 15 August).

Take a street food tour to explore the best culinary spots of the city with a food blogger – Mr. Van Cong Tu. He started his blog in 2005 and keeps sharing his enormous passion for food and culture for all these years.

He will meet you at your hotel lobby and you will have a walk through the Old Quarter past the old east gate to Thanh Ha market. This busy, eclectic market is alive with the sights and sounds of Hanoi and is the essence of Vietnamese culture. Along the way, you will try the local delicacies and listen to the explanation of Vietnamese food culture.

Continue your walk through the streets of the Old Quarter to Dong Xuan market to sample some local treats such as pho tui (rice noodles with scrummy slices of roasted pork, blanched bean shoots, scissored herbs, crushed nuts, and dried shallots placed on the top) and bun dau (a rustic dish of Northern Vietnam with rice vermicelli, tofu and shrimp paste). See dried goods and aromatics, the essentials of Vietnamese cuisine. Stroll up a "food alley" to see other interesting

dishes. Then walk down to Hang Than Street to view ceremonial cake stalls and taste a special French-influenced dessert. At the same time, learn about traditions and food gifts for celebrations.

Continue back into the Old Quarter via Hang Cot Street – check specially treated fruit which is dependable on the seasons and a common snack in Vietnam. Walk along Phung Hung Street through temporary market stalls where you can see the changing market scene in Hanoi and how modernization is shaping tradition. At the end of the tour, stop at one of the Old Quarter's busiest (yet smallest) coffee shops for a well-earned sit-down and coffee before transferring back to your hotel.

Hydrate with a welcome drink in Moc Village before departing on a cycling journey through nearby rice fields and quaint villages, making stops along the way at the neighborhood market. You will have a chance to interact and see how the locals sell their own products for a living. After that, we gather at the home of Mrs. Chin to join in a cooking class that will teach you how to make special bun cha and spring rolls, Hanoi style. With a full belly, say goodbye to the host family as we make our way to a 30-year-old tea plantation in Ri Village. A peaceful place to enjoy the greenery, this plantation plays an important role in providing tea products for the whole north of Vietnam. You will have a chance to help the owners harvest the tea leaves and pick the best part of the tree to make the highest quality beverage. Spend time at Mr. Duoc's house, the owner of the large tea farm, before departing for a scenic trip back to Hanoi city center.

DAY 6: HUE CITY TOUR & HOME - HOSTED MEAL WITH THE GASTRONOMY ARTISAN (B/D)

Once the imperial capital of the Nguyen Dynasty between the 17th and 19th centuries, Hue keeps an undeniable royal charm with its splendid emperors' tombs, ancient pagodas, and the remains of the Citadel.

Start your exploration with the Imperial Citadel at the center of the Complex of Hue Monuments, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Enter through the towering main gate and appreciate the magnificent architecture and gardens while your guide tells you about the events and the intrigue surrounding the former royal court. Despite being heavily bombed during the Vietnam War, some sections are incredibly well-preserved, and others have been carefully restored.

Then drive to the Thien Mu Pagoda, Hue's best-preserved religious monument. Built in 1601 the seven-storied tower pagoda, perched on top of the hill overlooking the Perfume River, is one of Vietnam's most recognizable icons.

In the afternoon, visit Khai Dinh Royal Tomb, whose architecture combines the elements of Eastern art and Western design. Notice the tomb's blackened concrete exterior and colorful mosaic interior. Continue to the Tu Duc Royal Tomb, the most impressive of all the royal mausoleums, built

by Emperor Tu Duc between 1864 and 1867. Then head back to your hotel to have some rest before dinner. On the way, you can have an optional stop at the incense stick-making house.

DAY 7: HUE – TRAVEL TO HOI AN THROUGH THE SCENIC ROUTE AND EXPLORE THE ANCIENT TOWN (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready to transfer from Hue to Hoi An by private car. You will drive through one of the most beautiful roads in the world - Hai Van Pass. You will be blown away by the stunning views of the mountains and the sea.

Upon arrival in Hoi An, you will enjoy the walking tour through the spectacular old town area. Between the 15th and 19th centuries, Hoi An was known as Faifo - a prosperous trading port, attracting Chinese, Japanese, Dutch, Portuguese, and Spanish merchants. This charming town still keeps its special atmosphere with a mixture of cultures from all around the world. Today, Hoi An is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage sight with its well-preserved architecture, pedestrian-only streets, and distinctive local cuisine, allowing visitors a glimpse of its illustrious past.

The perfect way to explore Hoi An is to walk through its narrow lanes and cozy streets. This morning you will explore the old merchant houses that combine the elements of Chinese, Japanese and Vietnamese architecture. Then admire the elegant beauty of the 400-year-old Japanese Covered Bridge, built in the 1590s by the Japanese community to link them with the Chinese quarters across the stream. Visit the Assembly Hall of the Chaozhou Chinese Congregation with its intricate woodcarvings. And finish your walk with a visit to the colorful market with stalls full of local specialties and products.

DAY 8: RED BRIDGE COOKING SCHOOL EXPERIENCE (B/L) – JOIN GROUP TOUR

Meet your guide at the hotel around 8:00 am and start this beautiful day with a welcome drink at Hai Cafe. Then visit Hoi An's colorful market to experience its amazing sights, sounds, and aromas. Interact with the local sellers and learn about all the ingredients to be used in the cooking lesson later. Next, you'll board a boat for a leisurely cruise along the Hoi An River to the Red Bridge Cooking School. On the way, get a close-up view of local river life and keep your camera ready for the many scenic photos. Visit the school's herb garden, then learn about some of Hoi An and Vietnam's most well-known dishes. The two-hour cooking class starts with Red Bridge chefs demonstrating each dish before you prepare the same dish by yourself. After a brief introduction to Vietnamese food carving (plate decoration), you'll sit down for a delicious lunch. Later we will transfer you back to your hotel.

DAY 9: TRAVEL FROM HOI AN TO HO CHI MINH AND EXPLORE SAIGON'S HISTORICAL SIGHTS (B)

Relish the remaining moment in **Hoi An** before your private driver escorts you to the airport to take the flight to Ho Chi Minh. Upon arrival, you will be welcomed and transferred to the hotel for check-in and quick refreshment.

In the afternoon, join the Ho Chi Minh City tour. With over eight million people and four million motorbikes, Saigon is truly a city that never sleeps. Despite its modernity, Ho Chi Minh maintains a strong link to the past, which you will explore today by visiting Saigon's most historic landmarks.

Start your tour with a visit to the Notre Dame Cathedral, a red brick edifice with twin spires constructed from materials imported from France (entrance is only permitted when no services are being performed). Then head across the square to the Central Post Office, built in 1891. It is one of the oldest buildings in the city, constructed in the colonial style, this post office had an important role in connecting Vietnam with other Indochina countries during French colonialism. Then take a short drive to the former Presidential Palace, the headquarters of the Saigon Government during the American War. Continue to the War Remnants Museum for a vivid perspective of the American War through the eyes of the Vietnamese. (Please note that some of the displays are very graphic.) End up your tour at a typical Saigon street coffee place chatting with the guide about the daily life of Saigoneses and learning some phrases in Vietnamese. Then head back to your hotel.

Overnight in Saigon

DAY 10: CU CHI TUNNEL & EVENING FOODIE TOUR ON VINTAGE VESPA (B/D)

Have breakfast at the hotel and depart for Cu Chi tunnels. The trip will take approximately one and a half hours drive. Upon arrival, you will have a short introduction followed by an introductory video about how the tunnels were constructed, and how the people survived in the harsh conditions of wartime.

Then, spend your time exploring the remaining area and tunnel systems, which included the living areas, kitchens, and bedrooms side by side with other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers. All this was to help people living inside the tunnels meet their basic needs. Afterward, special tea and cassava (guerilla food during the war) will be served.

DESTINATION: Hanoi, Mai Chau, Sapa, Quang Binh, Tu Lan cave, Ho Chi Minh

DURATION: 13 Days

Adventure is about experiences, so let's go off the beaten path on Vietnam exploration. Start your trip by discovering charming Hanoi on the back of the vintage Vespa bike. Travel out of Hanoi to a rustic, rural region that feels a world away from modern life. Mai Chau is an inspiring combination of stunning scenery and fascinating local culture. Next, visit the spectacular terraced mountainside of Sapa and Northern Vietnam. Bring your hiking boots and head out into the hills, stopping at minority villages to witness the traditional local life.

Then deep in the misty, vine-clad mountains along Vietnam's border with Laos at Phong Nha-Ke Bang National Park, one of the country's most beautiful and unspoiled regions. Trek through the jungles and discover breathtaking Tu Lan cave, as a part of the Son Doong Cave system, reputedly the largest cave in the world. Leaving Quang Binh behind, you'll fly to Ho Chi Minh, another spot of urban exploration. A restored Army Jeep will take you around the bustling streets and the city's historic landmarks, from the Opera House to the Notre Dame Cathedral. Also for a full picture of Vietnam's past, you'll stop by the War Remnants Museum which offers powerful insight into the Vietnamese War years.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO VIETNAM - HANOI ARRIVAL

Your Vietnam adventure begins with your arrival in Hanoi. Your private driver will meet you at the airport, holding a signboard with your name. He will escort you to your accommodation right in the heart of the city, with the fascinating Old Quarter at your fingertips. You can easily explore the city at your own pace or relax at the hotel after the flight.

DAY 2: HANOI VESPA TOUR (B/L)

These little trees are a traditional gift for the New Year, symbolizing luck, health, wealth, fertility, and peace.

Have a stop at the local coffee shop where you could try famous egg coffee. Then head back to Old Quarter passing by the Long Bien Bridge. It is a magnificent structure built over a hundred years ago which spans the red river and connects the Hoan Kiem and Long Bien districts.

Have lunch at a local restaurant and get back to your hotel.

DAY 3: HANOI - TRANSFER TO MAI CHAU (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready for your trip to Mai Chau. Your private driver will meet you at the hotel and take you on 4 hours trip to Mai Chau. Take a short drive to the center of the valley, where you will enjoy an easy walk following the village path around the valley, paying a visit to Hmong hamlets scattering from the bottom of the valley to higher mountain slopes. From high elevation you will enjoy the great view of the valley stretching under your feet. Continue your walk to the Red Dzaos village, where you will meet a group of women making handicrafts, including embroidered clothes and handbags. Later you will be transferred back to Sapa.

Overnight in Sapa

DAY 7: TREKKING THROUGH THE RICE TERRACES – LAO CHAI – TA VAN – GIANG TA CHAI – BACK TO HANOI (B/L)

The day is devoted to a beautiful hike through the breathtaking scenery of Sa Pa valley. Have breakfast and check out the hotel. Start the walk with a picturesque road where you can admire the rice terraces hidden behind the mist of the morning, a truly awe-inspiring sight.

Follow a small track crossing the Muong Hoa River and pass well-tended rice terraces on your way to the Black Hmong village of Lao Chai. Continue walking through the colorful rice terraces, and you will reach the village of Ta Van Giay. As you continue your trek along the Muong Hoa River, you will cross a small suspension bridge, roughly 2km from the settlement. Here you can discover a fascinating collection of rock carvings. These engravings depict some beautiful images of man, stilt houses, and some beautiful decorative patterns.

Have lunch in a local house. After lunch, continue your walk through the bamboo forest to Giang Ta Chai, a Red Dao ethnic minority village. After taking a rest nearby a waterfall to refresh, you start climbing uphill to a road where the car is ready for your trip back to Sapa. In the afternoon you will be transferred back to Hanoi.

Overnight in Hanoi.

DAY 8: HANOI - FLIGHT TO DONG HOI (B)

Relish the remaining moment in Hanoi before your private driver escorts you to the airport to take the flight to Dong Hoi. When you arrive at Dong Hoi airport, your driver will pick you up and transfer you to your accommodation. The rest of the time is free at leisure.

Overnight in Dong Hoi

DAY 9: PHONG NHA – TAN HOA – KEN CAVE – TU LAN CAMPSITE (B/L/D)

Get up early and have breakfast at the hotel. You will be picked up around 7:30-8:00 am and transferred to the meeting point. Here you will have a tour safety briefing, sign the release form, and receive the required equipment for the tour. And you are ready for your next adventure!

The trek starts with a flat path past peanut fields and grazing buffalo and cows. The adventure accelerates with a 30 m climb up a rocky hill to a small jungle opening where you can catch your breath before a 100 m descent down to Hung Ton Valley. Cross the valley on a flat path to enjoy a picnic lunch at the entrance of Hung Ton Cave.

Challenge yourself with more hills and jungle trekking before we walk down to Tu Lan Valley and your camp for the night.

Finish off the day with a swim into Ken Cave. A delicious BBQ dinner will be prepared and served by the porter team. After dinner, you can enjoy the evening games before sleeping in your comfortable tent. Composting toilets are provided at camp.

Overnight in Tu Lan

DAY 10: TU LAN CAVE - KIM CAVE - HUNG TON- TAN HOA (B/L)

The second day starts with a hearty breakfast and more cave exploration. Trek and swim through Tu Lan Cave and Kim Cave to arrive at the magnificent To Mo Valley.

Enjoy some snacks at the valley, then continue the journey by another swim through Hung Ton Cave. In Hung Ton Cave you will climb a 10-meter metal ladder with the extra protection of a safety line. Enjoy the beautiful views from the entrances into the jungle. A refreshing swim, dry passages, and amazing formations here will give you many opportunities for photos. After the third cave, we will head back to the starting point. Enjoy some snacks at To Mo Valley, and have lunch in the village when you arrive at Tan Hoa. Showers are available for those who would like to clean up and change and then depart back to Phong Nha.

Overnight in Dong Hoi

Have breakfast at your hotel before your guide and driver pick you up to begin your Jeep adventure. Drive through Saigon streets towards the Independence Palace/ the Reunification Palace. The palace is a symbolic destination of the end of the Vietnam War during the Fall of Saigon on April 30, 1975, when the North Vietnamese Army tank number 843 crashed through the gates of what was the residence of the President of the Republic of Vietnam.

Next, you will admire the Museum of American War Crimes/ the War Remnants Museum is the most popular museum in Ho Chi Minh City. It gathers a collection of the machinery, weapons, photos, and documentation of Vietnam's wars.

After the Museum, you will see Notre Dame Cathedral and the Old Post Office, which are the best highlights of old Saigon architecture and are located next to each other right in the heart of Ho Chi Minh City.

And then, Jeep will take you for a drive along famous roads in Saigon as Dong Khoi street, and Nguyen Hue street, and head to Ben Thanh Market, a lively market in District 1, where your guide can help you barter for goods. And then, Jeep goes to Bui Vien street and back to your hotel.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO VIETNAM – HANOI ARRIVAL

Welcome to Vietnam! Your new adventure begins with your arrival in Hanoi. Your private driver will meet you at the airport, holding a signboard with your name. He will escort you to your accommodation right in the heart of the city, with the fascinating Old Quarter at your fingertips. You can easily explore the city at your own pace or relax at the hotel after the flight.

Overnight in Hanoi

DAY 2: EXPLORE HANOI LIKE LOCALS (B/L)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and meet your guide, who will show you the real Hanoi life and take you through the locals' most favorite places.

Take a short drive to the historical Ba Dinh Square, where president Ho Chi Minh proclaimed the independence of Vietnam in 1945. Admire the outstanding architecture and charming atmosphere around this square. Then head to Lenin Garden, a communal place for locals. This garden also offers a perfect opportunity for watching the bustling daily life of Hanoians. Then it's time to explore some hidden parts of the city and drive through the small alleys with sewing shops owned by the same families for generations and see the old way of living there. Do not forget to bring your camera to capture this lovely area.

Have a walk to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first national university, built in the late 11th century. Enjoy the tranquil atmosphere of this quiet place and discover its role in the country's past.

Then visit the Ethnology Museum (closed Mondays), one of the best places to learn about Vietnam's cultural diversity. This museum has a big collection of cultural artifacts of each ethnic group in Vietnam. It is also an important research center.

After the museum visit, enjoy traditional Vietnamese lunch at the local restaurant.

In the afternoon, stroll around the charming Hanoi old quarter to explore the fascinating maze of back streets. Then have a walk along the bustling Nha Chung Street, full of vendors selling food, vegetable, and other products. Stop at the old French house where you will be invited for a cup of tea and an interesting talk about the history and life of Hanoi with the local family. Then say goodbye to your hosts and drive back to your hotel.

Duration: 7 hour

DAY 3: HANOI – THO HA VILLAGE AND GALAXY GROTTO (B/L)

Depart Hanoi for a 2-hour drive to the Tho Ha Village in Nho Quan.

Upon arrival, take a leisure biking trip from 5 to 15 km (depending on your wish), passing by sleepy villages and picturesque countryside sceneries. Then head to Dong Tam hamlet, where you will learn about the life of local farmers and take part in their daily activities such as catching crab, fishing, planting and watering plants, and more. After the busy time farming, return to the hamlet to join a cooking lesson with a local family. Learn how to cook the local specialties like sweet potato cake and toasted fish. Enjoy the meals you cooked for lunch, and then head to Nha Le Pier, where

you will board a hand-rowing boat and take a cruise down the Galaxy Grotto. The cave appears with a curling line under thousands of sparkling stalactites of various shapes. After the boat ride, you will be transferred back to Hanoi.

Overnight in Hanoi

Tour duration: 09 hours

Estimated arrival time at Hanoi: 17:30

DAY 4: HANOI – SAPA – CAT CAT – Y LINH HO VILLAGE (B/L)

After breakfast at the hotel, depart to Sapa. A frontier town 350km (217mi) northwest of Hanoi and close to the border with China, Sapa's terraced rice fields are some of the world's most beautiful. Upon arrival in Sapa, enjoy lunch at the local restaurant.

In the afternoon, Choose to walk from your hotel or be shuttled by a support minivan 2km (1mi) along hilly roads past terraced paddy fields to Cat Cat Village. Begin a leisurely 3km (2mi) walk through the village for an overview of the traditional customs and way of living of the ethnic Black Hmong minority. Explore a beautiful waterfall and the nearby remains of a hydroelectric power station constructed by the French during the colonial era.

Follow a dirt trail that winds through the mountains along a narrow river and enjoy the spectacular scenery of terraced fields, vegetable patches, and verdant hills as you arrive at the Y Linh Ho Village, also home to the Black Hmongs. Notice their traditional clothing made from hemp cloth dyed a deep indigo blue and decorated with batik flowers. Enjoy a rest stop by the river before trekking back to the road from where you will be transferred to your hotel.

Overnight in Sapa

Notes: Tour duration: 04 hours

Total trekking distance: 4km (2mi)

DAY 5: SAPA – LECH DZAO & THANH KIM VILLAGE (B/L)

Situated about 20km southwest of Sapa, Thành Kim valley is home to the Red Zao and Hmong people, who have been maintaining their strong and unique traditional customs for hundreds of years despite the influence of outside modern life. Follow the trekking path for an hour to reach Thanh Kim valley, then start descending towards a river, enjoying the cool fresh air and admiring the stunning views along the way. Cross the river on an old stone bridge and keep walking on the paved road to get to Lech Dzao village. Spend time stretching your legs in the village and talking to the villagers for a vivid view of their daily agricultural life. Learn about the embroidery techniques from the Red Zao women who usually sit in doorways working with their traditional textile

machine. On the way back to your hotel, trek through some terraced rice fields, which turn from green to yellow from May to early October. End your trip here.

Overnight in Sapa

Notes: Suggested times: 08:30

Duration: approximately 3.5 hours

Total walking distance: 3 km

Level of walking: easy

DAY 6: SAPA – HILL TRIBE MARKET BAC HA MARKET – HANOI (Sunday) (B/L)

Depart Sapa on a 3-hour drive along reasonably good roads to the Bac Ha Market, the largest and most colorful market in the area. Every Sunday morning, many different ethnic groups like the Flower Hmong, Phu La, Black Dzao, Tay, and Nung minorities gather to buy and sell local products including homemade wares ranging from embroidery, tobacco, and rice wine to farmyard animals such as chickens, pigs, horses, and buffaloes. This is also a place for the locals to catch up and meet friends over rice wine at the end of the week.

Then visit the Tay ethnic village of Trung Do, where you can meet and interact with the local people over a packed lunch. Continue on a local boat ride along the Chay River as it snakes between forested mountains. Transfer back to Hanoi in the late afternoon.

Overnight in Hanoi

Notes: Suggested departure time: 07:30

DAY 7: CRUISING AT THE MAGNIFICENT HALONG BAY (B/L/D)

In the morning, check out of the hotel, and get picked up by the Cruise team. Take the most scenic route to reach Halong Bay, taking you across the Red River Delta with emerald green rice paddies stretching for as far as the eyes can see.

On arrival at the pier, you will board the cruise and enjoy the fantastic views of limestone rocks and the karst grottoes. Have an utterly delicious seafood lunch and enjoy the time at the sundeck exploring the Bay.

The cruise will stop in a secret place where you will spend time kayaking or swimming, so you can explore the karst grottoes closer. Towards the evening, you will return to the boat for an early dinner, followed by some time at leisure. You can optionally attend the activities taking part on the boat or just relax.

Overnight on cruise

Notes: *In case of bad weather (the boat is not allowed to push off or not allowed to overnight in the sea), the Ha Long bay tour could be cancelled without notice. We will consider other replacement tours or a refund based on the specific circumstances.*

DAY 8: HA LONG BAY – BACK TO HANOI – FLIGHT TO HUE (B/L)

Rise early today to view the sunrise at the wonder of nature with breakfast served in the dining room. A Tai Chi class on the sun deck will awake your mind and muscles.

Then head off to visit the limestone cave full of stalagmites and stalactites. After your exploration return to the boat to check out and enjoy the brunch while the cruise is sailing back to the harbor. Later you will be transferred to the airport to board your flight to Hue. Upon arrival in Hue you will be transferred to your hotel.

Overnight in Hue

DAY 9: HUE HALF DAY ANCIENT CITY & TAM GIANG LAGOON (B/L)

Once the imperial capital of the Nguyen Dynasty between the 17th and 19th centuries, Hue keeps an undeniable royal charm with its splendid emperors' tombs, ancient pagodas, and the remains of the Citadel.

Start your exploration with the Imperial Citadel at the center of the Complex of Hue Monuments, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Enter through the towering main gate and appreciate the magnificent architecture and gardens while your guide tells you about the events and the intrigue surrounding the former royal court. Despite being heavily bombed during the Vietnam War, some sections are incredibly well-preserved, and others have been carefully restored.

After visiting the Imperial Citadel, you can choose between two royal tombs to visit:

(1) The Tu Duc Royal Tomb, the most impressive of all the royal mausoleums built by Emperor Tu Duc between 1864 and 1867. While the complex does include a tomb, together with pavilions and temples, no one knows exactly where Tu Duc was buried. All 200 servants who buried the king were beheaded to keep his final resting place a secret from grave robbers.

(2) The Khai Dinh Royal Tomb, whose architecture showcases elements of Eastern art and Western design, is considered the most elegant tomb. It is smaller compared to many other tombs, however, it is more flamboyant, with the largest dragons in the country forming the side walls leading up to the tomb. Notice the tomb's blackened concrete exterior and colorful mosaic interior in the spacious main building decorated with murals of the Four Seasons, Eight Precious Objects, and

Eight Fairies. After exploring the tombs, you will be transferred back to your hotel to have some rest.

Tour duration: 3.5 hours

WELCOME SUNSET AT TAM GIANG LAGOON

Have some rest at your hotel and get ready to continue exploring Hue. Your driver will pick you up from the hotel and transfer **you to An Dinh Palace**. Possessing fancy European architecture, An Dinh Hue Palace has been recognized by UNESCO as a world cultural heritage. Then visit **Ru Cha mangrove forest**, named after the kind of mangrove tree densely grown in the area. Ru Cha is considered to be a natural shield against Thuan An sea (Thua Thien Hue province)

Then arrive at **Chuon Lagoon (Tam Giang Lagoon)** to take the boat and listen to the introduction of the Tam Giang lagoon system. Pass the floating houses to take stunning sunset photos on the lagoon. Each moment on the lagoon is the most memorable moment. Take part in the fishermen's daily activities like beating the water, pulling the fishing nets, and catching fish. Then feel free to jump straight into the crystal blue water for a swim. Finally, visit the house or restaurant of the local family to enjoy the local specialty dishes or seafood and chat together. Then drive back to your hotel in Hue.

Overnight in Hue

Notes: Suggested departure time: 14:00

Tour duration: 5 hours

DAY 10: HUE – TRAVEL TO HOI AN THROUGH THE SCENIC ROUTE AND EXPLORE THE ANCIENT TOWN (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready to transfer from Hue to Hoi An by private car. You will drive through one of the most beautiful roads in the world - Hai Van Pass. You will be blown away by the stunning views of the mountains and the sea.

Upon arrival in Hoi An, you will enjoy the walking tour through the spectacular old town area. Between the 15th and 19th centuries, Hoi An was known as Faifo - a prosperous trading port, attracting Chinese, Japanese, Dutch, Portuguese, and Spanish merchants. This charming town still keeps its special atmosphere with a mixture of cultures from all around the world. Today, Hoi An is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage sight with its well-preserved architecture, pedestrian-only streets, and distinctive local cuisine, allowing visitors a glimpse of its illustrious past.

The perfect way to explore Hoi An is to walk through its narrow lanes and cozy streets. This morning you will explore the old merchant houses that combine the elements of Chinese, Japanese

and Vietnamese architecture. Then admire the elegant beauty of the 400-year-old Japanese Covered Bridge, built in the 1590s by the Japanese community to link them with the Chinese quarters across the stream. Visit the Assembly Hall of the Chaozhou Chinese Congregation with its intricate woodcarvings. And finish your walk with a visit to the colorful market with stalls full of local specialties and products.

Overnight in Hoi An

Notes: Tour duration: 03 hours

DAY 11: CYCLING IN CAM THANH VILLAGE & THANH DONG ORGANIC FARM (B/L)

Enjoy the delicious breakfast at the hotel and get ready for the countryside exploration. In the morning, you will drive to Vong Nhi village. Upon arrival, hop on the bikes and cycle through the village (around 6 km). Enjoy the stunning landscapes and peaceful countryside views, such as green coconut forest, and prawn and red snapper farms or immerse in the rustic beauty of rice fields.

Then arrive at Thanh Dong organic farm. This 10,000 sqm garden with fresh organic goods supports 10 local families for a living. Take a stroll around the vegetable garden and listen to the life-changing story of the farmers about how they have been approaching the organic method of cultivating herbs. Afterward, you will join the farmers in their gardening activities, like preparing and applying organic manure to the land, raking the ground, sowing herb seeds, and watering or picking vegetables.

Say goodbye to the farmers and take a ride in the unique Vietnamese basket boat along the Do River to The Field Restaurant. On the way, admire the beautiful scenery and local countryside life. Take part in a short cooking class to make Vietnamese family-style lunch. Enjoy the meals you cooked and get back to your hotel.

Overnight in Hoi An

Notes: Suggested departure time: 08:00

Tour duration: 03 hours

DAY 12: HOI AN – TRAVEL TO HO CHI MINH – A O SHOW AND DINNER AT DINNING ROOM (B/D)

You will be picked up at your hotel lobby and transferred to Danang airport for your flight to Saigon. Upon arrival, you will be welcomed and transferred to hotel for check in and free at leisure.

A O SHOW & DINNER AT DINING ROOM

In the late afternoon, your driver will take you to Saigon Opera House to see “A O Show”. This show is a combination of performing arts highlighting the traditional life and poetic scenery of Vietnam.

The show contains episodes of Vietnamese traditional folk games, dances, and circus acts with traditional and modern music in the background and using bamboo pipes and baskets by acrobats. This spectacular show is a great way to learn about the traditional cultural life of Vietnam.

After the show, enjoy beautifully decorated and presented dishes of innovative Vietnamese cuisine at the Dining Room restaurant. Then drive back to your hotel.

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh

Notes: *Suggested time: Public show: 18:00*

Duration: 3 hours

Venue: Saigon Opera House

DAY 13: CU CHI TUNNEL & SAIGON HALF DAY CITY (B/L)

Have breakfast at the hotel and depart for Cu Chi tunnels. The trip will take approximately one and a half hours drive. Upon arrival, you will have a short introduction followed by an introductory video about how the tunnels were constructed, and how the people survived in the harsh conditions of wartime.

Then, spend your time exploring the remaining area and tunnel systems, which included the living areas, kitchens, and bedrooms side by side with other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers. All this was to help people living inside the tunnels meet their basic needs. Besides, there are many hidden trap doors and dangerous traps within the maze-like tunnels for security purposes during the war. Afterward, special tea and cassava (guerilla food during the war) will be served.

Then you will drive back to Ho Chi Minh.

In the afternoon, join the Ho Chi Minh City tour. With over eight million people and four million motorbikes, Saigon is truly a city that never sleeps. Despite its modernity, Ho Chi Minh maintains a strong link to the past, which you will explore today by visiting Saigon's most historic landmarks.

Start your tour with a visit to the Notre Dame Cathedral, a red brick edifice with twin spires constructed from materials imported from France (entrance is only permitted when no services are being performed). Then head across the square to the Central Post Office, built in 1891. It is one of the oldest buildings in the city, constructed in the colonial style, this post office had an important role in connecting Vietnam with other Indochina countries during French colonialism. Then take a short drive to the former Presidential Palace, the headquarters of the Saigon Government during the American War. Continue to the War Remnants Museum for a vivid perspective of the American War through the eyes of the Vietnamese. (Please note that some of the displays are very graphic.) End up your tour at a typical Saigon street coffee place chatting with the guide about the daily life of Saigonese and learning some phrases in Vietnamese. Then head back to your hotel.

Tour duration: 08 hours

DAY 14: EXPLORE THE LUSH BEAUTY OF MEKONG DELTA (B/L)

Enjoy the delicious breakfast at the hotel and meet your guide at the hotel lobby. Today you will explore the maze of waterways and the lush green gardens of the Mekong Delta. Take a 1.5 hours drive to Ben Tre, situated in the Mekong River Delta. At the pier, embark on a fascinating motorboat that will take you to Cai Be floating market. See how locals sell their fruits and vegetables right from the boats. Then, take the rowing boat to go deeper into the countryside through small canals to enjoy a peaceful atmosphere.

Get back on a motor boat and cruise along one of the longest Mekong rivers observing the daily activities of the local farmers and fishermen.

Arrive at An Binh Island, where you will enjoy Vietnamese lunch at the local homestay.

In the afternoon, we will take you for a walk around the orchards to enjoy a cup of tea while listening life performance of the traditional Vietnamese music in the ancient house.

Now it's time to take a walk around the village and visit the local workshops to see how to make rice paper, coconut candies, and pop-rice. If you would like, you also can join the cycling trip through the village roads to see the local daily life at the orchard, school, church, pagoda, and traditional houses.

Then visit the brick kilns where you can see how the local people create beautiful clay pottery. Your cruise will end at Vinh Long city, from where you will head back to Saigon by private car.

DAY 15: TIME TO SAY GOOD BYE – HO CHI MINH DEAPRTURE (B)

DESTINATION: *Siem Reap, Battambang, Phnom Penh*

DURATION: *10 Days*

Cambodia will show you incredible beauty, fantastic food, and unique culture. More importantly, it is better when combined with some outdoor adventure. During the trip, you will discover the ancient temple ruins of the incredible Angkor complex by foot and mountain bike.

Take a boat trip to see the fascinating floating village in Tonle Sap Lake, which is the largest lake in South-East Asia that provides fish and irrigation for half the country's population. Then travel to the west of the great Tonle Sap Lake, and you will find the charming town of Battambang. Although it is less visited than Siem Reap and Phnom Penh, the town is home to some of the best-preserved French-colonial buildings in the country. Next, drive to Phnom Penh – once known as “the Pearl of the Orient”. It is a lively and engaging city, which is in the process of growing confidence and vitality despite its recent turbulent history.

where you could have a rest after the flight or head to the Pub Street to explore the city at your own pace and have a delicious meal.

Overnight in Siem Reap

DAY 2: SIEM REAP TOUR BIKING (B)

After breakfast, we cycle to the main temple attraction for an extensive exploration of the magnificent 12th-century Angkor Wat. You will realize why this great temple is simply unsurpassed by any other monument. Continue spinning through a little unnoticed village to visit Ta Prohm, see how the jungles are covering the temple, and admire the power of nature. Upon entering via the North Gate, we proceed further to a little sandstone temple in the jungle called: Ta Nei, which is called a smaller version of Ta prohm. Other sights en route are - Victory Gate and Ghost Gate before we return to Siem Reap.

Overnight in Siem Reap

DAY 3: SIEM REAP TOUR (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel. Today we continue to explore the jungle-covered temples by visiting the Roluos Group. The monuments of Roluos, which served as the capital of Indravarman I (reigned 877-89). See Preah Ko temple, which was built in the late 9th century and dedicated by the King to his ancestors in 880. Continue exploring the sandstone temple Bakong, the largest and the most interesting temple of the Roluos group. It has an active Buddhist monastery just north of the east entrance. Then visit Lolei, which is built on an islet in the center of a large reservoir (now rice fields) by Yasovarman I, the founder of the first city at Angkor. Then stop to visit the well-preserved temple of Banteay Srei with beautiful carvings. Along the way, we make a stopover at the Preah Dark village to visit the Banteay Samre Temple adorned with impressive reliefs depicting scenes of Vishnu as well as Krishna legends.

Overnight in Siem Reap

DAY 4: TONLE SAP TOUR (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel. Today you will visit the floating village of Chong Khneas, located 10 kilometers south of Siem Reap. Take a trip in a traditional wooden boat on the Tonle Sap Lake, the "Great Lake" of Cambodia, and see how people live right above the water.

Spend the afternoon by visiting the "Chantiers Ecoles - Les Artisans d'Angkor", which provides training to young Cambodians to revive the ancient Khmer traditions of stone carving and wood sculpting. Then take a drive to the Pouk district about 15 Km from town, to visit the silk farm, a fascinating farm/workshop where you can see the entire silk creation process, including growing the food for the silk worms, breeding the worms, silk extraction, and refinement, traditional dyeing, pattern creation and looming. Retail silk in a souvenir shop. On the way back, visit the Western

Baray (Baray Occidental) measuring 8 km by 2.3 km which provided water for the intensive cultivation of lands around Angkor.

Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 5: SIEM REAP - TRAVEL TO BATTAMBANG (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready for your trip to Battambang. Upon arrival in Battambang town and check-in at your hotel, we will drive along the picturesque Sangker River to Wat Slaket Pagoda, the former residence of the provincial Buddhist patriarch.

Continue your exploration by visiting Ek Phnom Temple, which is an 11th-century Angkorian-era ruin built as a Hindu temple under Suryavarman I. The temple consists of prasats on a platform with carvings in pretty good condition and a modern pagoda that sits next to the ruin. The river road you take to drive to Ek Phnom from Battambang passes through small villages and rice paddies.

After temple exploration, you will visit a market where Prahoc, the Cambodian fish paste is made, and steam-sticky rice is cooked in bamboo. Return to town for a short walk to the local market.

Overnight at the hotel in Battambang.

DAY 6: BATTAMBANG EXPLORATION (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel. Today we will drive to the village of Ksach Puoy on the banks of the Sangker River. It is home to many well-preserved traditional Khmer wooden stilted homes. This area also grows a variety of tropical fruits and, after the rainy season, farmers plant all kinds of vegetables along the fertile river banks. Here you will learn about traditional agriculture and taste juicy oranges, sweet pineapples, and many other fruits.

Not far from Ksach Puoy is Cambodia's first vineyard – Prasat Phnom Banan Vineyard – you can pop in if you like, learn about producing wine in the tropics, and enjoy a spot of wine tasting! After a few kilometers further, you will arrive at the well-preserved 11th-century mountaintop Angkorian temple of Phnom Banan. After climbing the 350+ steps, you will be treated to a wonderfully peaceful setting with superb views across the surrounding countryside. Observe the small villages dotting the endless rice paddies and sugar palm trees.

In the afternoon, visit the Muslim village and learn about their vocations, traditions, and everyday life. Have a talk with a Buddhist monk and learn about Buddhism and monastic life as well. Wrap your day with a scenic Bamboo train ride experience in the countryside of Oudombong village with the local people.

Overnight at the hotel in Battambang.

DAY 7: BATTAMBANG - DRIVE TO PHNOM PENH (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and start your day by visiting Phnom Sampov, which is the national resort. On the top of Phnom Sampov mountain, there are temples and three natural wells, named Pkar Slar, Lo Khoun, and Ak So Pheak. Have a leisure time at the resort, then return to the town. If time permits, we also will explore the French colonial town, where you could see many French architectures. Then your private guide and driver will take you to Phnom Penh.

Overnight in Phnom Penh

DAY 8: PHNOM PENH EXPLORATION (B)

Today you will visit Royal Palace, a royal residence now where His Majesty, the King of Cambodia, and the royal families live. It is like a small town of royal dynasties. Then explore an incredible solid silver-floored Silver Pagoda. It has 5000 silver tiles on the floor and exposes the biggest golden Buddha statue in Cambodia. Then continue to Raung Damrei Museum and National Museum, with over 5000 objects on display including Angkorian era statues, lingas, and other artifacts.

Spend the rest of the time at the Russian Market, a great place to hunt for souvenirs, curios, and silks. Finally, visit Wat Phnom Temple, one of the most important pagodas in Phnom Penh. It was built in 1373 on an artificial hill by the wealthy widow Daun Chi Penh.

Overnight in Phnom Penh

DAY 9: PHNOM PENH - COOKING CLASS (B/D)

Have free time in the morning to relax or explore the city at your own pace. In the afternoon, you will learn more about Cambodian gastronomy, which is rich and varied, with tastes and flavors from the neighboring countries. Have hands-on experience in cooking the local dishes with the help of the chef. Later enjoy the meals you cooked for an early dinner.

Overnight in Phnom Penh

DAY 10: TIME TO SAY GOODBYE – PHNOM PENH DEPARTURE (B)

Relish a healthy breakfast on the final day of your trip to Vietnam. Complete the hotel check-out formalities, after which you can visit the local markets to buy souvenirs for your loved ones. Later your private driver will transfer you to the airport to take your flight back home.

DESTINATION: Luang Prabang, Xieng Khuang, Vientiane, Khong Island, Pakse

DURATION: 10 Days

This incredible Laos trip is a great opportunity to escape from the busy lifestyle of the developed world. Find your inner peace and joy as you explore the serene and picturesque landscapes of Laos. Luang Prabang is a must-visit place. It is a Unesco World Heritage Site and Laos' ancient capital. Explore its old-world charm and Buddhist temples.

Hike to the magnificent Kuang Si Falls, the largest waterfall in Luang Prabang. En route to Xiengkhouang, enjoy some of the most impressive scenery in Southeast Asia. This tour will also take you to the three sites of the strange giant stone jars (Plain of Jars) whose use and significance are a mystery to this day. Travel to the sleepy capital Vientiane and spend time wandering past French colonial mansions and watch a fiery sunset over the Mekong.

This Laos tour also takes you to the off-beat destination of Laos. In Southern Laos, you will see the fertile Bolaven Plateau, known for its cool mountain climate, numerous dramatic waterfalls and plantations that produce some of the world's finest coffee. You will also be exploring the incredible

Vat Phou temple complex, which pre-dates Cambodia's Angkor Wat, in Champasak province. And at Si Phan Don (Four Thousand Islands), enjoy a boat tour around the islands in the Lower Mekong River.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO LAOS – LUANG PRABANG ARRIVAL (B)

Upon arrival at the airport, our driver will meet you and transfer you to the hotel. Luang Prabang is perhaps the best-preserved traditional city in Southeast Asia. Its tranquility and charm with its splendid natural scenery and cultural sights make it one of the most delightful places to visit in Laos.

After a short rest, we will visit the impressive stupa of Wat Visoun and the shrines of Wat Aham and Wat Mai. We then climb up to the top of Mount Phousi for an enjoyable exploration of the sacred, gilded stupa, and watch a beautiful sunset above the city and the Mekong River. From there, we go to explore the night market, where you can find a lovely selection of handmade textiles made by the local hill-tribe people surrounding Luang Prabang.

Overnight in Luang Prabang

DAY 2: LUANG PRABANG — PAK OU CAVES (B)

After breakfast, enjoy a short tour to the city's oldest temple Wat Sene and the magnificent Wat Xiengthong. We then board a cruise upstream on the Mekong River. Enjoy a panoramic view of the tranquil countryside along the way to the mysterious Pak Ou Caves. These two caves are linked and crammed with thousands of gold lacquered Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes left by pilgrims.

En route, we stop at the village of Ban Xanghai, where the local specialty — rice wine — is produced. Once back to Luang Prabang, we take a short drive to Ban Phanom, a village well known for its traditional hand weaving.

Overnight in Luang Prabang

DAY 3: LUANG PRABANG — KHOUANGSI WATERFALL (B)

Get up early to get the opportunity to participate in the daily morning rituals of saffron-clad monks collecting alms (ubiquitous sticky rice) from the faithful residents. This tradition is very unique in Laos, being the only Buddhist nation still preserving the tradition. From there, we will visit the morning Phosi Market where you can see a big diversity of local products, such as dried buffalo skin, local tea, vegetables, and woven products made by hill-tribe people.

Laos is also known for its traditional handicrafts, and today you will travel and visit local villages of Laos ethnic minority groups at Ban Ouay and Ban Thapene. Then we will drive to the beautiful Khouangsi Waterfall, where you can swim in the turquoise pools or walk along the forest paths.

Overnight in Luang Prabang

DAY 4: LUANG PRABANG — XIENKHOANG (B)

After breakfast, we check out from the hotel and start our trip to Xiengkhouang. On the way, we will visit the National Museum (closed on Tuesdays) at the former Royal Palace, which displays a lovely collection of artifacts reflecting the richness of Laos culture dating from the days of the early kings right through the last sovereign. You will also visit the Central Market.

Then we will drive 306km uphill the mountain surrounded by wonderful natural sceneries to Xiengkhouang, which was devastated by the American bombing between 1964 and 1973. Upon arrival, we will visit the Plain of Jars, an impressive archaeological site where hundreds of large stone jars are scattered all over the plateau. If time permits, we see the old capital of Muang Khoun and the nearby villages, home to the Hmong hill tribe people.

Overnight in Xiengkhouang

DAY 5: XIENKHOANG – VIENTIANE (B)

Relish the remaining moment in Xiengkhouang before your private driver escorts you to the airport from where you will be flying to Vientiane. At Vientiane airport, your driver will pick you up and transfer you to your respective accommodation. You will have the rest of the day to yourself.

DAY 6: VIENTIANE CITY TOUR (B)

Today you will see the major sights of the capital, including the oldest Wat Sisaket, the temple with thousands of miniature Buddha statues, and the former royal temple of Wat Prakeo. Then continue to Laos' national precious heritage, the famous and sacred structure of That Luang Stupa. On the way, have a stop to take some pictures of the imposing Patuxai war monument, which is well-known as Vientiane's own Arc de Triumph.

In the afternoon, continue the sightseeing tour to Buddha Park, where you will see a scattered enchanting collection of Buddhist and Hindu sculptures on the Mekong riverside meadow, close to the Friendship Bridge. It has approximately 200 religious images dating back over 500 years. Finish your day with a spectacular view over the Mekong River.

Overnight in Vientiane

DAY 7: FLIGHT FROM VIENTIANE TO PAKSE – DON KHON ISLAND (B)

After breakfast, we catch an early flight to Pakse. On arrival, our driver and guide will meet you and take you for a drive on the National Road No 13th south to Champassak to visit the fascinating pre-Angkorian ruins of Vat Phou.

Take your time to explore these intriguing Khmer ruins. This wonderful archeological site of Khmer civilization dates back to the 10th century, predating the famous Angkor Wat in Cambodia. We then continue our journey by long tail boat to Don Khon, the largest island in the South Mekong River region, also known as the Four Thousand Islands. It is one of the most scenic areas in Laos.

*Overnight on Don Khon Island***DAY 8: DON KHON ISLAND – FOUR THOUSAND ISLANDS (B)**

After an early breakfast, we explore the local villages of Ban Khone, where you will see an array of relics from the French colonial era and retrace the old colonial past, including old French colonial buildings and the remnants of the first Lao railway with its locomotive. We then continue exploring the Four Thousand Islands by boat. Visit the Liphith Waterfall, one of the most beautiful waterfalls that marks the border between Laos and Cambodia. If we are lucky, we may even see the rare freshwater dolphins at Ban Hang Khone. After, return to Ban Nakasang and drive to the famous Khone Phapheng Falls, the largest waterfall in South East Asia.

*Overnight on Don Khon Island***DAY 9: DON KHON ISLAND — TADLO — PAKSE (B)**

Today, we leave Don Khon Island and continue our journey towards Tad Lo, through the Bolaven Plateau. The Bolaven Plateau is known for its cooler temperature and being high above the Mekong Valley. Rivers run off this high plateau in all directions before plunging into lush forests along a series of spectacular surging waterfalls.

A trip to the plateau provides a refreshing break from the heat and allows you to observe the cultivation of rich coffee, tea, cardamom, bananas, and other agricultural products. During this trip, you will have a chance to venture off the beaten track and discover some of the lesser-known areas of Laos, and explore the wild beauty of this southern region. We also visit Tad Lo waterfalls and the surrounding villages of Alak, Nge, and Katu. We return to Pakse by late evening.

*Overnight in Pakse***DAY 10: PAKSE DEPARTURE (B)**

Relish a healthy breakfast on the final day of your trip to Laos. After completing the hotel check-out formalities, you can visit the local markets to buy souvenirs for your loved ones. Later your private driver will transfer you to the airport to catch your flight back home.

DURATION: 14 Days

Head to Battambang town with French Colonial architecture and other modern temples. Taste the special steam-sticky rice cooked in bamboo there and walk in a small local market. The trip will end with a pagoda built up with 5000 silver tiles, Royal Palace, and Wat Phnom Temple in Phnom Penh.

You will learn how to pick the best tea leaves to make the most wonderful beverage in Vietnam. Carry on with the tea production at his small workshop, where most of the work is manual.

Then have a short drive to Moc village, where you will meet your next host Mrs. Chin, who will teach you how to cook local Vietnamese dishes. Later have the meals you made for lunch in a beautiful tropical garden.

Have a short break after lunch, and join Mrs. Chin for a walk around the village. You will visit some local families to understand the rural lifestyle and learn how tofu, conical hats, and other local products are made. Then have a cycling trip through beautiful paddy fields to meet your last host Mr. Chinh, who will meet you with fresh mint lemon juice. All ingredients are freshly picked from his own garden.

Wrap up your countryside tour with traditional feet soak in warm water with herbs, following the traditional recipes of the Muong ethnic minority. It will relax you (and your feet) after cycling around the village.

Then your driver will transfer you to Mai Chau.

Overnight in Mai Chau.

DAY 3: MAI CHAU – KAYAKING TRIP (B/L)

Today you will have a great opportunity to discover Da River (Black River) and enjoy the scenic landscapes with limestone islets sprinkled all around. Jump on a kayak and explore the true beauty of nature in Northern Vietnam. Visit the fishing village, where you will meet and talk to the local fishermen to know more about their lifestyle. Paddle through islets and explore the fairy pond.

Have lunch with local meals and spend more time kayaking. Later you will be back at your hotel.

DAY 4: MAI CHAU - CYCLING AT LUSH GREEN MOUNTAIN SIDE (B/L)

Then have a cycling trip (around 5 km) through the quiet roads passing by the rice fields and rivers. After the cycling trip, you will be transferred to your hotel to have a rest after a busy day.

Overnight in Tam Coc

DAY 6: NINH BINH - CRUISE IN THE NATURAL WONDER OF THE WORLD (B/L/D)

Have a hearty breakfast at the hotel. Today you will make your trip to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Vietnam. We leave the greeny rice fields of Ninh Binh behind, bound for the serenity of Lan Ha Bay, the less touristy area of Tonkin Gulf on the South of Halong Bay.

Upon arrival at Tuan Chau International Marina, you will board the cruise.

Get acquainted with the facilities on board as the boat starts sailing into the bay. Savor your first hours of cruising on the sun deck and let your eyes wander over the breathtaking scenery of Lan Ha Bay - Cat Ba Archipelago. Have lunch on board.

Later the cruise vessel approaches a secret hideaway place with beaches, caves, and coves, where you can see the spectacular natural beauty of about 400 islands. Have a stop here for kayaking and swimming in the clear water of the bay.

Then return to the boat and enjoy the afternoon tea while watching the sunset from the sun deck. Later join the Vietnamese cooking class led by the cruise chef, followed by a delicious dinner.

In the evening, have a relaxing time on the boat or try your luck with squid fishing.

Overnight on cruise

DAY 7: HALONG BAY – HANOI – FLIGHT TO HO CHI MINH (B/L)

Rise early today to view the dawn at the Wonder of the Nature World with breakfast served in the dining room. A Tai Chi class on the sun deck will awake your mind and muscles.

Then head off in a bamboo boat to explore Dark and Bright Cave, a stunning limestone structure of two caves, which you can access only by boat.

Then return to the boat to check out and enjoy the brunch while the cruise is sailing back to the harbor. Later you will be transferred to Hanoi airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh. Upon arrival at Ho Chi Minh airport you will be escorted to your hotel.

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh

DAY 8: EXPLORE THE VIBRANT CITY BY JEEP CAR (B)

Today you will explore the most remarkable places of Ho Chi Minh city in military-style by Jeep.

Have breakfast at your hotel before your guide and driver pick you up to begin your Jeep adventure. Drive through Saigon streets towards the Independence Palace/ the Reunification Palace. The palace is a symbolic destination of the end of the Vietnam War during the Fall of Saigon on April 30, 1975, when the North Vietnamese Army tank number 843 crashed through the gates of what was the residence of the President of the Republic of Vietnam.

Next, you will admire the Museum of American War Crimes/ the War Remnants Museum is the most popular museum in Ho Chi Minh City. It gathers a collection of the machinery, weapons, photos, and documentation of Vietnam's wars.

After the Museum, you will see Notre Dame Cathedral and the Old Post Office, which are the best highlights of old Saigon architecture and are located next to each other right in the heart of Ho Chi Minh City.

And then, Jeep will take you for a drive along famous roads in Saigon as Dong Khoi street, and Nguyen Hue street, and head to Ben Thanh Market, a lively market in District 1, where your guide can help you barter for goods. And then, Jeep goes to Bui Vien street and back to your hotel.

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City

DAY 9: TRAVEL FROM HO CHI MINH TO SIEM REAP (B)

Relish the remaining moment in Ho Chi Minh before your private driver escorts you to the airport to take the international flight to Siem Reap. When you arrive at Siem Reap airport, your driver will pick you up and transfer you to your accommodation. The rest of the time is free at leisure.

Overnight in Siem Reap

DAY 10: SIEM REAP - ANGKOR WAT (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and start your sightseeing tour of the Angkor area. Start your exploration with the wondrous ancient ruins with the South Gate of Angkor Thom, which is famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone. Continue your sightseeing to the impressive Bayon Temple, the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King, and the largest as well as the most complete temple of Angkor Wat. This architectural

masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. We will stroll around this massive edifice, seeing the many galleries with columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards, and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple. Then visit the famous jungle-covered temple of Ta Prohm. Here the enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers embrace themselves in the stone foundations of the structure giving the impression of man's creation being reclaimed by the powerful forces of nature.

Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 11: SIEM REAP - BANTEAY SREI (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready for your next adventure. Today you will visit Banteay Srei. This complex of temples was constructed in the late 10th century by a Brahmin counselor under the powerful king Rajendarvarman. This temple is wrongly known as the citadel of the woman, however, the modern appellation refers to the dedicated beauty of the carvings. En route, we will stop at Pre Rub (turn the body) temple, constructed in the late 10th century and dedicated to Hindu gods. It reflects the common belief among Cambodians and is used to conduct funerals.

Then visit Preah Khan temple, built by King Jayavarman VII and dedicated to his father. It is a huge and highly exportable monastic complex, which is served as a Buddhist monastery and school, engaging over 1000 monks. Continue to Neak Pean, a small island temple located in the middle of the last Baray, constructed by a Khmer king in the Angkor area.

In the evening we will take a Tuk Tuk, a small open-sided taxi, to cruise around the suburb of Siem Reap town for a blessing ceremony by Buddhist monks for happiness, prosperity, and safety for your journey.

Overnight in Siem Reap

DAY 12: SIEM REAP - TRAVEL TO BATTAMBANG (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready for your trip to Battambang. Upon arrival in Battambang town and check-in at your hotel, we will drive along the picturesque Sangker River to Wat Slaket Pagoda, the former residence of the provincial Buddhist patriarch.

Continue your exploration by visiting Ek Phnom Temple, which is an 11th-century Angkorian-era ruin built as a Hindu temple under Suryavarman I. The temple consists of prasats on a platform with carvings in pretty good condition and a modern pagoda that sits next to the ruin. The river road you take to drive to Ek Phnom from Battambang passes through small villages and rice paddies.

After temple exploration, you will visit a market where Prahoc, the Cambodian fish paste is made, and steam-sticky rice is cooked in bamboo. Return to town for a short walk to the local market.

Overnight at the hotel in Battambang.

DAY 13: BATTAMBANG SIGHTSEEING - TRAVEL TO PHNOM PENH (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel and take some rest until our guide and driver will take you to more sightseeing and drive you to Phnom Penh. Visit Ksach Puoy village, located on the banks of the Sangker River. It is home to many well-preserved traditional Khmer wooden stilted homes. This area also grows a variety of tropical fruits and, after the rainy season, farmers plant all kinds of vegetables along the fertile river banks. Here you will learn about traditional agriculture and taste juicy oranges, sweet pineapples, and many other fruits.

Not far from Ksach Puoy is Cambodia's first vineyard – Prasat Phnom Banan Vineyard – you can pop in if you like, learn about producing wine in the tropics, and enjoy a spot of wine tasting! After a few kilometers further, you will arrive at the well-preserved 11th-century mountaintop Angkorian temple of Phnom Banan. After climbing the 350+ steps, you will be treated to a wonderfully peaceful setting with superb views across the surrounding countryside. Observe the small villages dotting the endless rice paddies and sugar palm trees. Then continue the trip to Phnom Penh.

Overnight in Phnom Penh.

DAY 14: TIME TO SAY GOODBYE - PHNOM PENH DEPARTURE (B)

Have breakfast at the hotel, and we will visit the Royal Palace and the Silver Pagoda, which is named because of its floor made up of 5000 silver tiles. The treasures found inside include a solid gold Buddha encrusted and weighing 90 kg. and a small 17th-century emerald and baccarat crystal Buddha. Later, visit Wat Phnom Temple, a famous landmark of Phnom Penh. Then our driver will take you to the Phnom Penh International Airport for your flight back home.
